## *A note from Father Kevin*

I have always felt that Labor Day Weekend, the unofficial end of summer, leaves a number of people feeling a bit sad. Maybe it's the anticipation of changing schedules for children and families, a shift in the way people work or feel on the job, the few hours of sunlight or the slow changes in the weather that make people feel different – and not always in a positive way.

Now there are exceptions to this. Some children look forward to a return to school, for example, as do many parents. And some people love the fall for the familiar activity of things like football and the fall sports season. But for others, this may not be the case.

Coming at this from a faith perspective, what can we do for ourselves or for others to make September an easy month for whatever reason? What can we do to make it better?

Well, aside from remembering that there are still a good number of summer days, we can benefit from bringing the help of God into these days of transition. The Gospel of this weekend gives us one way to do that.

In the Sunday Gospel from Matthew, Jesus tells us that wherever two or three are gathered in His name, to pray, that He is there and that praying together in His name can be an effective thing. Where this happens for us in an obvious way is when we gather together in Church. We may often forget this fact as we offer most of our prayers, and offer them effectively as well, in our personal prayer time at church or at home.

Gathering in church, however, is a special time set aside when, along with other prayers, we are praying for each other, especially during the days and months that may be more challenging for all of us and for our children.

So keep on praying wherever and whenever you do on a daily basis, keeping in mind that we pray together in His name not only in the many places we offer our daily prayers, but in the special time we have together in Church.
