A note from Father Kevin

Over my first six months at St. James, I have come to know the spirit of faith and generosity that has made this a great parish. Throughout St. James' 164 year history, it has remained strong through prayer, service, financial sacrifice, and the belief that parish life matters in the lives of our families, our children and all of those seeking to know God. In short, St. James is a vital part of so many lives in this community, both young and old.

Working to maintain the strength of this parish and to continue its work of bringing Christ to others, depends on what we do now to keep it on a solid foundation. That involves not only maintaining the strength of our programs, the quality of our prayer life, the commitment to serve and the vitality of our community life, but also what we do financially.

On the weekend of January 29th, we begin a six week process of asking everyone to reflect on their financial generosity to the parish. We are asking you to examine the possibility of either giving for the first time or increasing your support.

Every parish in the diocese has gone through this process over the past two years. St. James will be one of the last in this process, as we have been focusing on the need to complete the successful Capital Campaign that has helped us to update our facilities and set funds aside for future capital needs.

I am fully aware we are living in economic times that are a challenge to many. I also know that some people in our parish are giving all that they can at this time. Understanding these limits, the intention of this process is for all of us to reflect on how and when we can help our parish income meet the expenses that help so many. For many of us, that time is now.

As was pointed out in our financial report last October, our offertory income, the main source of operating the parish and its ministries, has not been increasing over many years, however we all know that operating expenses have increased. This often leaves us short of what we need to operate from month to month. Annual fund raising events have been critical and beneficial, but even so, expenses are soon to catch up to us.

If all this sounds rather dire, it's not meant to be. Having gone through this increased offertory process at my last assignment, I believe that if everyone does something, the combination of many gifts will get us where we need to be and keep us there.

Please keep an open mind to the process before us and know how grateful I am for the many ways that people are generous to their parish, not only financially, but with their time and talent as well. St. James has a great history and that generosity will ensure its continued strength as a source of prayer, education, support and spiritual strength for so many.
