## *A note from Father Kevin*

I was thinking the other day as I was looking ahead to my first year in the parish, of how important it is to have some balance in our lives. Our jobs, housework and chores, and school is, of course, necessary and important. We all need to earn a living, make a contribution, and develop our skills and talents through the gift of education.

The challenges we face, and know all too well, is that our work life or school life take the largest share of our time throughout the week. As a result, we may be missing the opportunity to give attention to family, friends and other valuable pursuits—like time for prayer, silence, personal reflection or some of the physical activities that keep us in better health.

This week in the Gospel, we hear Jesus ask, “What profit would there be to gain the whole world and forfeit your life?”

Now certainly we are not out to gain the whole world, but what is true is that sometimes, in giving too much of our life to work or the pursuit of material things, the work world begins to own us, causing us to forfeit our time to do other things that are of benefit to ourselves and to others.

There are many ways to interpret the question, but essentially Jesus is concerned about people... about us...about giving too much to worldly things, without giving attention to what really matters—like family, friendship, prayer, and personal enrichment.

Keep in mind that Jesus is concerned about what we have gained or lost in the journey of

life. And as hard as it is to not be overly focused on work or school, which do take a lot of our attention by necessity, I think what Jesus is reminding us of, is that there has to be time for other, non-material things.

This week, take a few minutes to think about this: Outside of work or school, what can I do for myself or my family to gain in other ways that attend to the personal and spiritual needs of life?
